TRISTAN'S TECH TIPS

GPay & Apple Pay

You may have noticed people paying for things with their phone, or their watch. This is due to an app found on the phone called Google pay (GPay) & Apple Pay (and technically Samsung Pay & others but this is the main two) GPay is found or downloadable on Android devices & Apple Pay is on iPhones.

Phones must also have "near field communication" or NFC capabilities in order to wirelessly talk to eftpos terminals so not all phones are compatible.

You can link digital versions on your cards on the app including your myki card & even your vaccine certificate so it can be quite useful in a pinch.

If you are worried about security, linking a bank card requires permission from you & your bank, the latter of which requires answering of security questions as well as one-time codes sent from the bank for linking purposes.

It also requires having some sort of lock on your phone, such as a pin number before it will let you put a card on the app for security reasons. Please do **not** use your bank pin number as your phone pin number, it is a significant security risk.

If leaving your wallet at home, or not having to pull it out at shops sounds appealing to you, why not give it a go?



Leopold Garden Club

We are now well into autumn. The summer vegetables are well and truly finished. The flower gardener can have much to look forward to in autumn, particularly autumn flowering bulbs. Many people when thinking in terms of bulbs think of the spring flowering. There is a wide range of autumn flowering bulbs that flower from late summer into autumn; the obvious reason being the weather is stable, so insects can pollinate more easily than in spring. If you look you will see more than just the autumn crocus. In my own garden there are nerines, naked ladies (Belladonna), Jacobean lily (Sprekalia formosissimo), autumn zephyrlilly (Zephyranthes candida), and a bulb often referred to as elephant ears because of its extremely large fleshy leaves (Haemanthis coccineus) with its little red flower. When looking at your flower garden next year it may be worth considering the autumn flowering bulbs.
