

TRISTAN'S TECH TIPS

Ad blocker for mobile

Ads are intrusive and annoying, maybe even malicious. And on modern smart phones there's no exception. Here is what I recommend.

iPhone/iPad:

Ka-Block!

Free to use, download off the Apple App Store, open app and follow the instructions to block ads on Apples' "Safari" Web browser. We use Ka-Block! On our iPads so I know it works

Google Android (all phones with "Play Store"):

Ad block plus

Free to use and works with "Google Chrome" when downloaded from "Play Store", open app and follow instructions to block ads.

Bonus – Samsung Phones using "Samsung Internet"

Ad block plus for Samsung Internet – and lots more alternatives

Go to settings (the 3 lines on the bottom right of the screen next to the tabs) in the Samsung internet app, tap on "Ad Blockers" and choose an ad blocker from the list. Download the app, open it and follow the instructions to turn it on and block ads on Samsung Internet.

Spring at last! Time to plant in earnest, if not earnest I will be frank but there is an importance in being earnest.

The weeds have relished what sun we have seen in the last few weeks. The seedlings I have planted in the last 2 weeks outside have started to come up; beetroot, silverbeet, lettuce, radish, broccoli, cabbage.

I have also started to put my tomato seed into punnets under glass (you can use a sunny window sill just remember, do not let the seed dry out.

It's also time to plant your dahlias, liliums, bearded irises or divide and transplant them.

Come along to the September Garden Club for company, coffee and information. I had the opportunity to give out papyrus, tree dahlias, seedlings (poppies, carnations, hollyhock) as well as seedlings of that most reliable of plants...lettuce
